We're raising funds again this year to help children attend Summer Camp. Please mark "Summer Camp" on your tithe envelope.

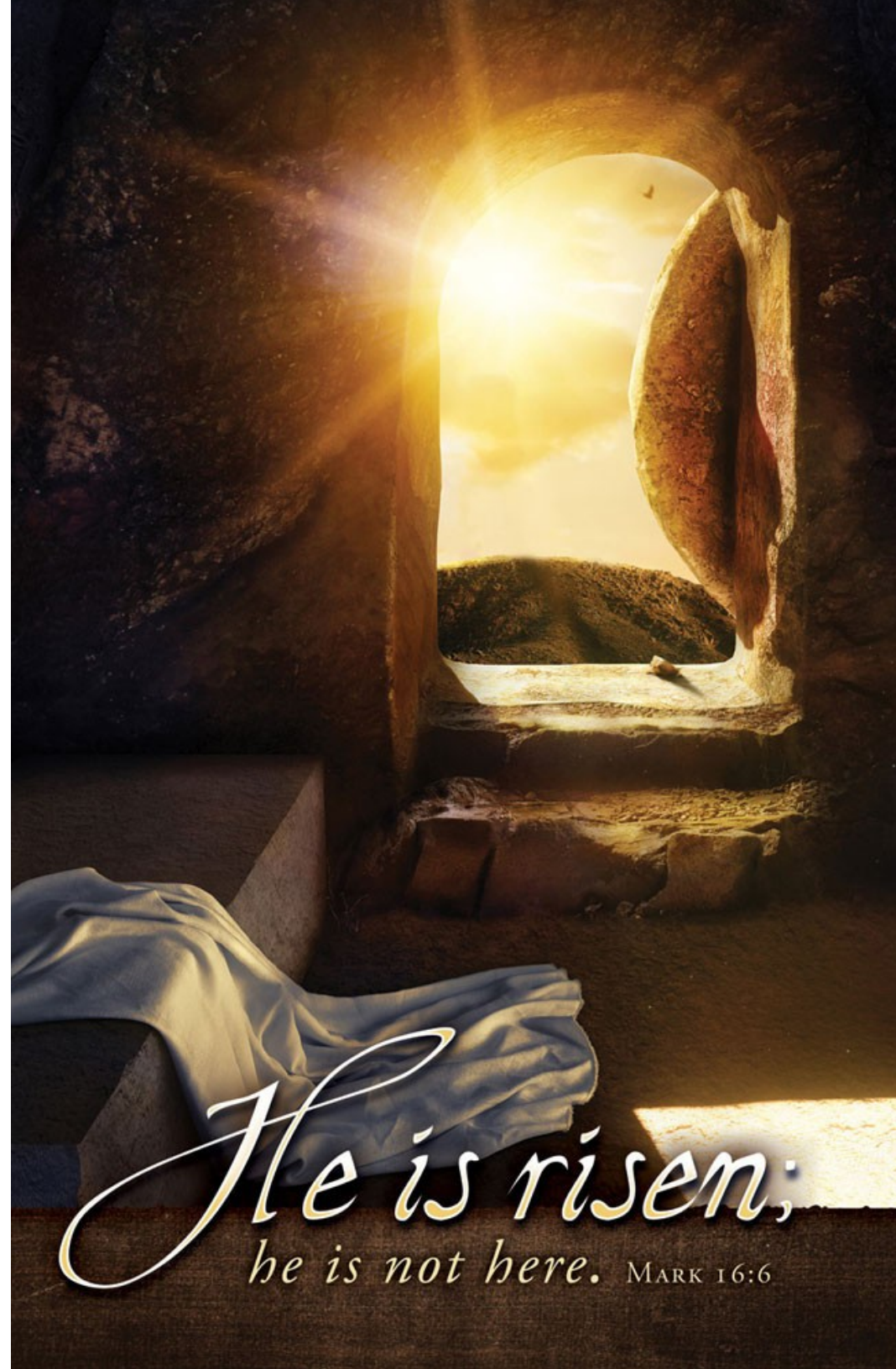

Help Light Up Samar, Philippines



On the island of **Samar**, a small Adventist group is experiencing something remarkable. With very little money but incredible faith, they are sharing Jesus with their community and people are responding. In just the past few months, **over 40 people have been baptized**, and many more children and adults are studying the Bible with joy and determination.

But here's the part that changes everything:

While their hearts are on fire, their resources are not.

Children who choose to follow Jesus receive Christian books printed locally; simple, beautiful tools that help them grow in faith. A Bible in their language costs only **\$4**, and a full set of children's books for the school and baptismal classes costs so little... yet for them, it's still out of reach.

They've reached out to the Tryon SDA Church for help. The entire need is **15,000 pesos (about \$300)**; an amount that, for us, is small... but for them, it opens the door for dozens of young believers to hold the Word of God in their hands.

Mission Trip to Powell Valley SDA School

Imagine a small Adventist school tucked in the mountains of Dryden, Virginia; quiet, worn, and waiting for new life. For years it has served its community, but now it needs hands, hope, and a fresh start. This is where we get to step into the story.

On the weekend of **May 16**, our church is heading up, just **2.5 hours from Tryon**, to help restore the Powell Valley SDA School. The building isn't a teardown; it simply needs care, cleanup, and the kind of teamwork that turns a tired space into a place where children can learn about Jesus again.

This is where we get to make a difference: If no one steps in, the school stays closed. If we show up, even for a day, we help reopen an Adventist school for a community that desperately wants one.

We'll work **Sunday through Tuesday**, with meals provided at the church. For a limited time a block of rooms is available at the **Quality Inn in Big Stone Gap** for **\$99/night**, so reserve your room soon, or you can make it a simple day trip. Even one day of your time makes a real difference.

This first phase prepares the school for a homeschool program this fall, with the goal of bringing in a full-time teacher the following year. Our help moves that vision forward.
